TREASURER'S REPORT

This is my 10th and final Treasurer's report.

As is usual at this time, being so close to the end of the financial year, the financials have not been audited and therefore I present them as draft and unaudited.

For the year ended 30 September 2022 we managed a draft and unaudited profit of \$148,114, which represented an unfavourable variance to last year of \$361,188.

At a very high level, the favourable variance can be broken down to two (2) main items, being government grants (\$385,000 unfavourable) COVID government assistance (\$31,600 unfavourable) offset by Football operations (\$60,000 favourable) and Bowls Club operations (\$30,000 favourable)

The unfavourable variance from government grants is the funding received in 2021 to help progress the New Change Rooms Project and Water Harvesting Project.

Capital expenditure for the year was \$313,888 made up of the following major items:

- Change Rooms Project \$237,790 (partial grant funding)
- New Storage Shed \$30,723 (grant funded)
- Clubhouse Upgrade/Equipment \$9,524 (no grant funding)
- Bowls Club Equipment \$7,471 (no grant funding)

I would like to thank the Club staff and my fellow Board members for what has been another challenging year.

SENIOR FOOTBALL REPORT

It was always going to be difficult in the 2nd season of the FQPL2 after the Grand Final success of 2021.

Again a big thank you to all the coaches and volunteers throughout, of course this club would not be the same without them.

Glen Volker and Scott Hawkins who steered the FQPL, U23 and U18 ships through the season, the effort and dedication these lads put in was second to none. The contribution of Blair Rainbow for everything he does for the FQPL squads all year is always without question. Leaders on the pitch like Mitch Beven and Matt Hornby behind the scenes and leading by example on the pitch.

The lads got off to a slow start to the year but our FQPL senior team eventually finishing 7th and the U23 squad finishing equal 7th. Slightly behind last years efforts on paper but very good considering the slow start.

We were back to 4 mens city teams, 2 over 35 teams, 1 over 45 team and 1 over 30 womens team. All these squads had strong performances throughout the year. To the individuals who coached and managed these groups thank you for your efforts as always.

As always, the next year will bring new challengers. Initial player trails are in the process of happening with plenty of outside interest. 3 city teams have already confirmed their commitment for next season along with the over 35's and 45's. With the strength of the club behind it the senior cohort for 2022 will prove to be very strong across the board.

This will be my last report and as such I would like to extend a huge congrats to both Craig and John for steering the club through so many years. The stabilizing factors of consistency and continuity coupled with the ability to make the hard calls when they are needed has placed the club in a super position. Also Reuben for his knowledge on everything football and admin, we could not do anything without you.

Refer below a couple of dot points on why GTFC has such a strong future from Juniors through to open competition.

- 16 out of a squad of 18 players played at least once in u23s
- Total of 52 appearances in u23s
- 2 players also came off the bench for 1st team for a total of 3 appearances

FEMALE FOOTBALL REPORT

2022 has seen the female player group continue to grow with participants in all ages from the 3-5 year old Squirts program, Miniroos from Under 7 to Under 12, Divisional Teams in Under 13, Under 15 and 16, the Senior Women's FQPL2 First and Under 23 squad and last but not least, the Over 30 Women's squad.

For those interested in statistics, this totalled 217 active players. These numbers can be seen as a huge vote of confidence in the work our Committee, Coaching Staff and Parent volunteers have put into developing and improving the program.

With the FIFA Women's World Cup coming to Australia in 2023, the outlook is bright for Female Football and Grange Thistle will continue to work at delivering the best experience for its members through quality facilities and coaching.

Senior Football:

A huge improvement for the women's program after finishing second bottom in both 23s and 1st team in 2021, they managed to achieve their highest ever finishes in 2022. Both teams finished 7th out of 12 teams, comfortably avoiding the relegation zone and the 23s had a real chance of finals football late into the season.

The culture continued to be fantastic and the vibes around the entire squad of 36 players was excellent. The coaching staff of Brook Henry-Martin, Tony Kirchner and Andrew Crawford implemented new formations and style of play, utilising technical training sessions to challenge and improve each player alongside planned sessions with the purpose of being more defensively solid and creating more goal scoring opportunities.

The additions of new senior players to the club Sharnelle, Nicole, Emily, Julie, Gabi and Katibell in addition to Grange junior girls Libby, Maddie, Clara, Liv and Sienna following the pathway into senior football.

FQPL 2 - Highlights include a fantastic 4-0 smashing of AC Carina in front of a bumper crowd at Lanham Park, with Kate Lawson scoring from a set piece routine on her birthday. We also beat 3rd place UQ at home 1-0 and drew 1-1 away effectively taking them out of the title race. We obliterated Easts 4-0 at home as well with some incredible possession football and drew 0-0 with finals participants Broadbeach United, showing that we can mix it with anyone at this level.

Ash Gould scored 15 times to finishing top scorer (and 3rd overall in the league), supported by Emily Morris with 9 goals.

FQPL 2 U23s - Highlights included a last minute goal to win 1-0 away at Pine Hills (later beating them 4-0 at Lanham Park) and taking this momentum into beating Easts 5-0 the next week. We beat Robina convincingly without conceding a goal; 4-0 and 3-0. We also had a player at the top of the league leader board - Jess Papallo for most yellow cards!

Junior Football:

With our Miniroos teams growing each season, more opportunities are opening for the youngest players in our Club.

Our Divisional (U13 upwards) squads are beginning to form some quality combinations and have improved consistently throughout the year.

We thank all parents who are volunteering to Coach and Manage the teams for their wonderful support for these young girls.

JUNIOR FOOTBALL REPORT

Junior football at Grange Thistle in 2022 was a long but fruitful season, with the impact of COVID hanging around. Throw in record rain falls in January, February and April which lead to the delay of the seasons, and numerous weekend games to be rescheduled most of them midweek.

In addition to the above-mentioned issues, it was GTFC first year in the Advanced Junior Football Pyramid as part of the FQPL Development competition for our U13, U14, U15, U16 & U18.

More than 800 Juniors played in teams across the club this year, with Saturday mornings at Lanham Park serving as a significant weekly footballing and community event in the local area.

I would like to thank every player, parent, coach, manager, and volunteer on the role they played in making 2022 at GTFC a success

On-field results across the FQPL Development & our FQ Metro teams from U13-18 were positive with our U16 FQPL Development team winning the Premiership, Our U13 FQ Metro 5 team winning the Grand Final and our U16 FQ Metro Div 2 team unfortunately losing their Grand Final.

Our Academy teams in the U8-12 age groups were also highly competitive on a weekly basis.

Congratulations to Technical Director Max Zamfirescu on a highly productive second season in the role, with improved organization of academy sessions, increased skill acquisition among players, and improved coaching levels, all key focuses.

Plaudits also to the many volunteers and older-age junior players who have helped run match days at Lanham Park in roles across refereeing, coaching, canteen duty and setting-up and putting-away equipment – your contribution is part of what makes Thistle such a special club.

Our Club referees under the mentorship of the Referees Coordinator Josh Buerckner once again did a stellar job on Saturdays and Sundays resulting in high standards of officiating, and obtaining hugely positive feedback from coaches, managers, and parents from visiting teams.

2023 is another year Grange Thistle will participate in the new FQ advanced football pyramid. After a yearlong assessment Grange Thistle have been placed in FQ Academy 4, this decision affects our u10 to U12 Academy teams and U13 to U18 teams. As a club we were not happy with our assessment, but we are working towards keeping our license and working our way up the pyramid. This will all coincide with our new TD Paul Montgomery starting in early January.

Thank you again to everyone who made this year's football possible - and a special thank you to all the team Coaches and Managers, whose hard work is at the heart of our Club.
